- Small Tarp or something to cover the ground under your Tent

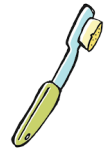


Modest Clothing

- Shoes: closed-toe.
- Flip flops for shower and beach time only
- Rain gear, poncho and/or umbrella

- Soap
- Shampoo

- Brush or Comb
- Deodorant
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Lip balm
- Tissues

Other Items
